***NB: We will be outside for a large part of the day on Thursday and British weather can be temperamental. Please wear suitable footwear and be prepared for rain!***

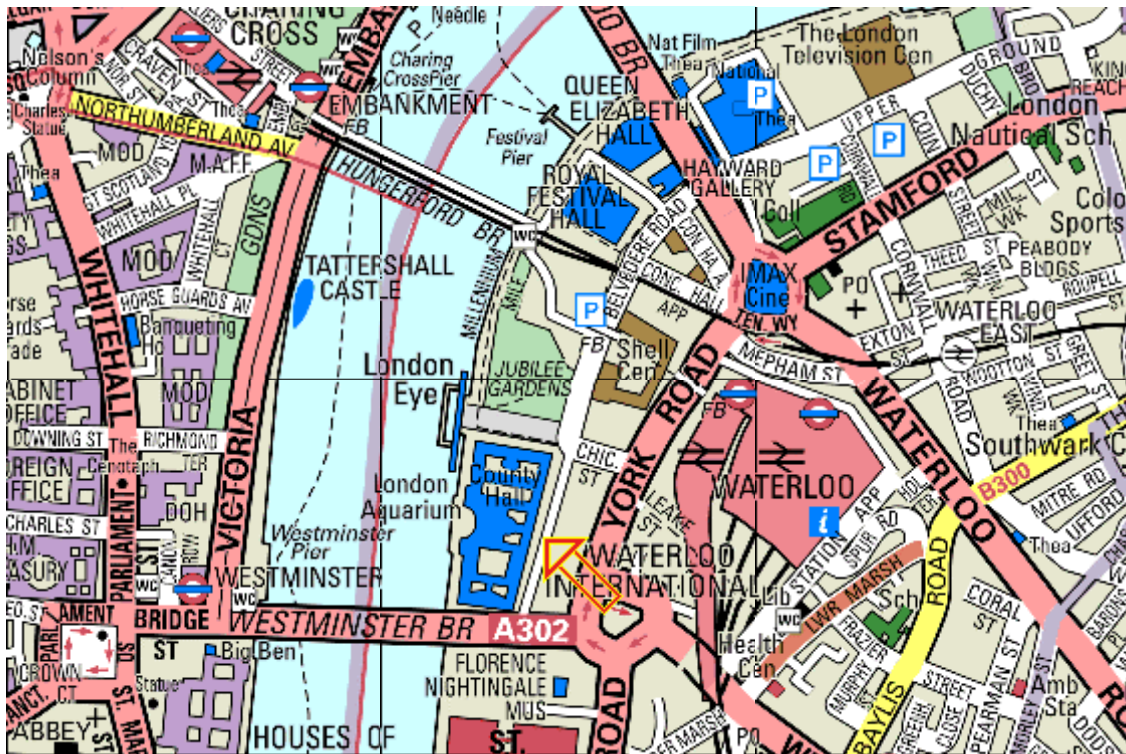
## Hotel information
